

1. one who enters into military service proceeding from the will or from one's own choice or consent
2. attesting to creditable conduct
3. a government in which the supreme power is vested in the people and exercised by them directly

usually involving periodically held free elections

4. an establishment that serves as an informal social club (for soldiers or a community's teenagers)
5. a system for or act of selecting individuals from a group (as for compulsory military service)
6. a former member of the armed forces
7. the status of being a native or naturalized person who owes allegiance to a government and is entitled to protection from it
